Requirements for Product Certification.

The Namibian Standards Institution (NSI) operates Product Certification Schemes in line with Section 23 of the Standards Act, 2005 (Act No. 18 of 2005). After successful completion of the certification process, a manufacturer is awarded a license to use the NSI Product Mark of Conformity on certified products. The manufactures shall comply with the following provisions:

- 1. Apply using the PRC-P02-FB: Product Certification Application Form.
- 2. Provide a company registration certificate.
- 3. Provide a fitness certificate of the establishment or manufacturing plant.
- 4. Pay applicable certification fee.
- 5. Ensure that product(s) are available for sampling and testing.
- 6. Provide evidence of conformance to the relevant Product Standard(s).
- 7. Provide evidence of existence of a production control system.
- 8. Allow NSI inspectors to assess conformance of product and production processes.
- 9. Sign a binding contractual certification agreement with NSI and adhere to the rules therein which include;
 - i. Use of mark of conformity
 - ii. Notification of changes to NSI
 - iii. Reference to Product Certification
 - iv. Surveillance activities
 - v. Actions to be taken upon suspension, withdrawal, or termination of certification.
